Safari information

The drive through the Serengeti Safari is at your own risk. We are not liable for any damage to your vehicle caused by animals. Please follow the instructions of our team at all times and ask for help when necessary.

Do not feed the animals
Feeding the animals is dangerous and prohibited. It will make them ill. This also applies to all monkeys in the Jungle Safari. Please also do not eat near the animals.

Jungle safari
Pay attention to your belongings - otherwise the monkeys may take them.

Dogs
Dogs are welcome here but please keep them on a leash. They are not permitted in the walk-through enclosures or on the footpath leading to the elephants as this may frighten your dog, as well as disturb our animals. For safety reasons you may not take your dog with you if you are travelling on the park's own vehicles (e.g. the Serengeti bus, on the VIP safaris or any one of the rides).

Smoking areas
With respect to the environment and other guests, we kindly ask you to smoke only in the designated smoking areas. Please put all cigarette butts in the ashtrays in those areas.

Caravans, convertibles, etc.
Convertible cars and cars with folding roofs are for reasons of safety not permitted to drive along the Serengeti Safari route. The same applies to caravans and campers with loose attachments, bike carriers and similar. The risk of injury to the animals is particularly high.

Opening hours

Open daily in the summer season from 21 March to 01 November 2026.

OPEN
We are open from 10 am except from 02 July to 31 August when we open at 9.30 am. Our rides open an hour after the park has opened.

CLOSED
We are open until at least 5 pm off-season and until 6 pm or 6.30 pm in the peak season. The ticket office and Serengeti Safari normally close at 4 pm except for 02 July to 31 August, when they close at 4.30 pm.

Petting Zoo Safari and walk-in enclosures close thirty minutes before the park has closed.

Please note that there may be cancellations or changes to attractions and shows due to weather conditions or for technical reasons.

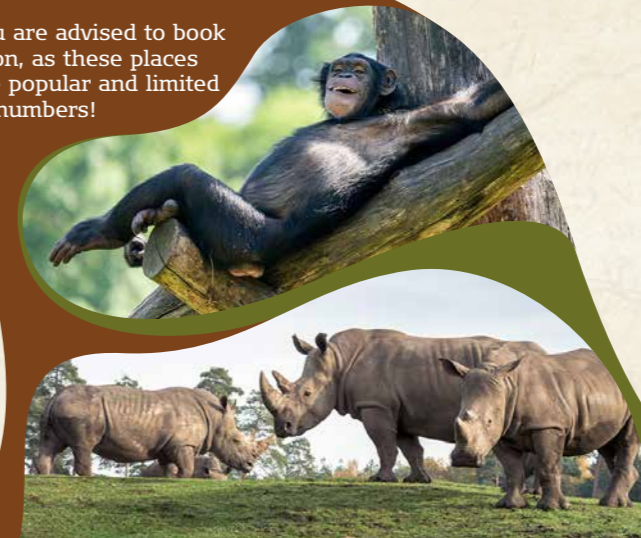
